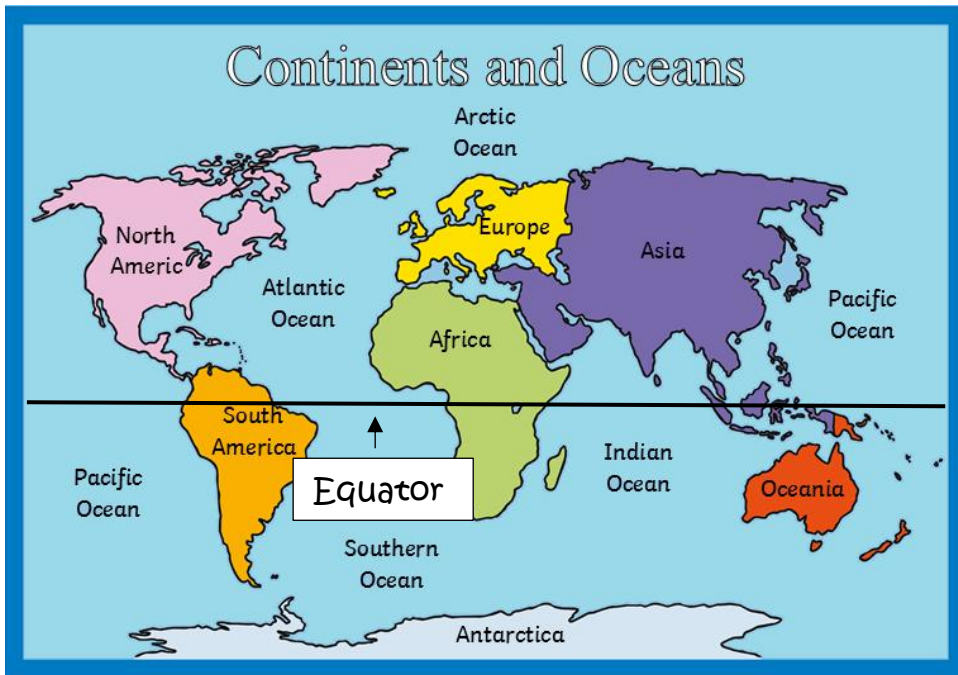


# Around the world

## Continents and Oceans:

There are 23 countries in North America, the largest country is Canada. The current population is 371,107,709.

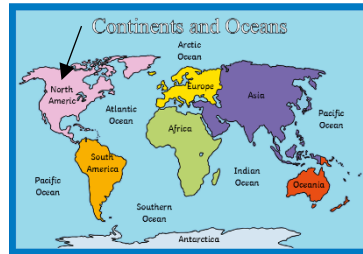
Physical landmarks: Niagara Falls, Grand Canyon and Redwood national park.

Islands.



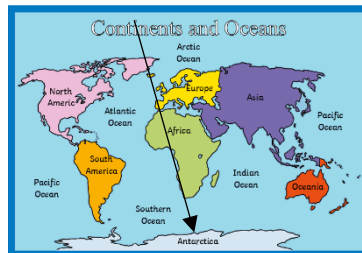
## Antarctica:

## Asia:

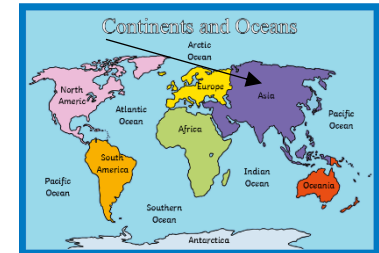
There are 48 countries in Asia, the largest country is Russia by area and China by population. The current population is 4,698,369,698.

## Africa:
