Lesson 1: Chronology of World and British history.

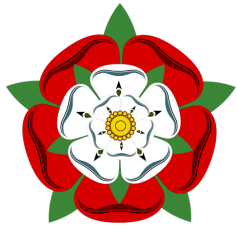
Lesson 2: The Battle of Bosworth and the start of the Tudor dynasty.

## English

For the first two weeks of the term, we are revising previous skills in grammar and applying these to different writing pieces.

Throughout the rest of the half term, we will be focusing on the works of William Shakespeare. Including:

- Macbeth
- Romeo and Juliet



We have also introduced a 'Word of the Day'. Make sure you ask your child about this and see if they can use it within a sentence.

## Maths

Number and place value is a key building block to all areas of maths.

We will begin with place value of numbers: value of digits, partitioning (splitting a number into parts), writing words to numbers and numbers to words, comparing, ordering and rounding numbers.

After this, we will focus on the four operations and different methods of calculation.

## Science

We are learning about Electricity. We will start by looking at renewable and non-renewable sources of energy. After this, we will move on to practical activities where children get to make circuits and investigate different questions. Our findings will be written into a report allowing the children to apply skills from literacy and maths.

## RE

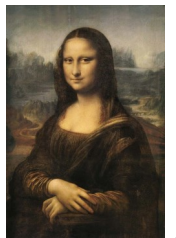
Year 6: Is it better to express your beliefs in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity?
